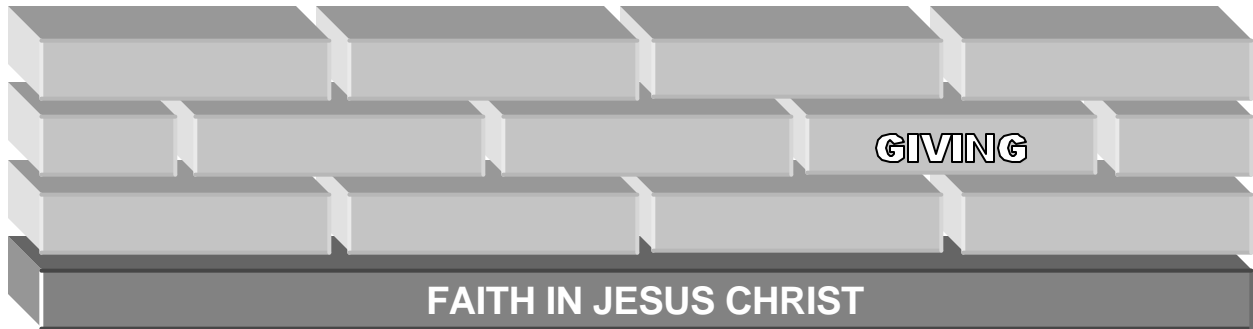


## LESSON 7

- ☞ Some people claim that they will begin giving when they can afford to do so. Some individuals may never have reaped bountifully, because they have not yet \_\_\_\_\_ bountifully. (vs.6)
- ☞ Some people decide on the spot how much to drop in the plate, but we are to give according to how we have \_\_\_\_\_ in our heart. (vs. 7)
- ☞ Some people give their tithe, but they are resentful because they feel pressured to do so. What should this person remember? (vs. 7) \_\_\_\_\_

Thought: Everything we have ultimately came from God. As stewards of His possessions, he lets us keep 90% and only asks for 10% back.
